

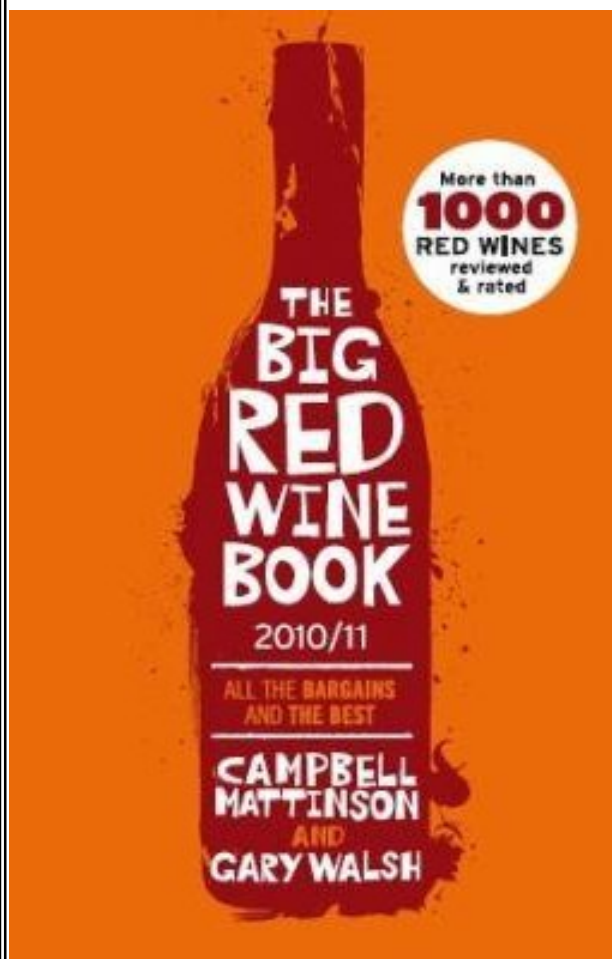

It tastes of rich plums, malt, mint & liquorice & provides plenty of drinking pleasure."
